Students who have met all requirements of the program will receive upon graduation with their diploma, a certificate of proficiency in the language and culture of their specialization.

Dear Colleague:

In order to receive a certificate in Chinese, Japanese, or Korean Languages and Cultures, a student must complete a substantial piece of independent research (20-25 pages):

- Primarily (i.e., at least 50%) about China, Japan, or Korea
- A research paper (i.e., one that produces new knowledge)
- Based in part on sources in Chinese, Japanese, or Korean
- In the area of the humanities or social sciences
(i.e. in language, literature, history, religion, art, archaeology, film)
